Summer Camps

The Holy Cross Summer Camps encourage hands-on learning as children explore. Children will talk, hypothesize and problem-solve with their peers, to gain a richer understanding of each topic. Each week includes a curriculum based on sensory, art, Jesus time, literacy, science, and movement activities, along with outdoor play as the

weather permits! Each program is designed for 3-5 year old children. All children need to be fully potty-trained and turn three by May 1, 2015. The cost is \$75/week, which includes snacks and materials. Please submit a separate form for each child.
